# REMINDERS

**Golf Cart Pairing Up** -You must pair up when leaving the 1st Tee and make sure there are 2 riders in each cart. If you do not, it is careless and adds age to our cart fleet!

**Practice Range Mats** – When the balls are set to hit on the range mats, you must only hit on the mats. They are intended to protect and prolong the natural grass tee for all golfers.

**Back Driving Range** - Please keep golf cart traffic limited to the cart path or beside the south practice tee. Our maintenance staff is trying to improve and beautify our practice area and the traffic elimination will help substantially.

Native Grasses & No Mow Areas – You must not drive golf carts or push carts through the native areas. There should never be any vehicles in the grass; this will not be tolerated.

**Safety First** – Please wait for the golfers ahead of you to clear the landing area before you hit your next shot. It only takes one errant shot to change our community. Are you really impatient enough to jeopardize someone's life? If you are, think about someone doing the same thing to your spouse, child or best friend. It's just a game!

**Golf Shop Vendors** – Please know just because you don't see it in the golf shop doesn't mean we can't order it! We can compete and usually offer a better price on new product than most golf stores. Please ask a member of the golf staff for a price if you don't see it in the golf shop.

**Golf Course Cart Towels** – Please, please return any cart towels you may have accidentally taken home or left in your vehicles.

Cigarette Butts & Trash – Please keep River Landing Green & Clean: "No butts about it!" We would like to inform all smokers we do have ashtrays for golf carts, so please ask the staff for one and help us keep our golf courses free of butts!!!

# GOLF PRO'S CORNER

### **CLYDE JOHNSTON INDUCTED INTO THE LOW COUNTRY HALL OF FAME**

On Saturday March 24th, our own golf course architect Mr. Clyde Johnston, a Hilton Head, SC resident, was inducted into the Low Country Hall of Fame in a well-deserved ceremony. Clyde came from a family that loved golf as his father was the golf coach at Wake Forest College (before it became a university), his sister played on the LPGA for many years, and everyone played and loved the game. I've known Clyde for over 20 years now as his sister and I worked together on a fundraising tournament for The United Cerebral Palsy, that he and his family participated in every year without exception. Clyde loves River Landing, still takes pride in calling our courses his best designs, and plans to visit again this summer. During his induction speech, Clyde told two very interesting stories of which most people are unaware.

In the first story, Clyde told how his father dabbled in golf course design but only from a volunteer standpoint. He offered Clyde the opportunity to sit at his drafting table at a very early age and, after seeing his son's wonder and understanding of golf course design, made the comment "you know, you could make a living at this." Later he realized his dad knew exactly what he was doing but Clyde was still willing to share the second story to possibly discount the first.

While coaching for Wake Forest, his father had recruited and offered a scholarship to Buddy Worsham, one of the better high school players in the nation. Buddy was willing to accept the scholarship under one condition, that Coach Johnston would extend a scholarship to one of his close high school friends from Pennsylvania. It went against his better judgement but the coach wanted Worsham so badly het relented and offered the young man his last scholarship. The young man's name: Arnold Palmer!

If you have the chance to discuss golf course design or the game of golf with Clyde, you will see the glimmer in his eye and you will understand why this well-respected gentlemen was inducted into the Low Country Hall of Fame. Golf runs through his veins like blood!



### RIVER LANDING SUPPORTS HABITAT FOR HUMANITY



River Landing residents have been supporting Habitat for Humanity for many years. In 2017 the Habitat for Humanity of Duplin County affiliate merged with Cape Fear Habitat for Humanity – located in Wilmington and supporting New Hanover, Pender, and now Duplin Counties. By merging the two affiliates we are able to leverage the considerable resources (including a well-qualified paid staff) of the Cape Fear affiliate. The Cape Fear affiliate builds about 12 new homes per year and this merger will support building homes in Duplin County more frequently. Most (but not all) of the volunteers from Duplin County live in River Landing. The plan is to build the next home in Wallace in 2019. In addition to the planned home in Wallace, a home was recently completed in Burgaw with plans for a second home next door in the near future.

Candidates for homes are carefully screened based on income, genuine need and their willingness to become a productive partner in the Habitat program. Currently only about 35% of the applicants are found to be eligible for a home. Selected candidates must perform at least 250 hours of sweat equity in support of home building or other supporting tasks for Habitat. Those selected all participate in an in-depth training program to teach them the responsibilities of home ownership and to empower them to take charge of their new home obligations. Homes are sold to the candidates based on the assessed value of the home, and the new homeowner is responsible for the mortgage payments, taxes and insurance. This program offers a hand up (not a hand out) to deserving candidates who would otherwise be unable to obtain their own mortgage to get them into affordable housing.

We welcome volunteers to participate in this program. No special skills or tools are needed to participate, just a willingness to help out where you can. All of the tools and equipment are provided, and a paid site supervisor is on site to oversee the work and provide training and advice to the men and women volunteers. Typically the volunteer work days are Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays, but most of the volunteers work on Wednesdays, with work hours from 8 AM until Noon. Car pools are organized to provide transportation to the work sites as desired. Dean Hanson has been coordinating the volunteers by sending information out on e-mail to identify who will be participating and who is willing to drive.
