



If that is the case, we have just the right answer for you, and it is called Creative Quilt Enthusiasts (CQE). What, may you ask, is CQE? We are an active group of quilters and fiber artists in River Landing. Some of us started sewing in our youth, mastering traditional hand-picked sewing and quilting methods, while others discovered this art form later in life. Despite our different journeys, we all share a love for creativity with fabric and color.

CQE meets monthly, September through June, at the River Landing Fitness Center and we have been doing so for over a decade. The River Landing Residents' Gardening Committee have re-designed and renovated the Memory Garden at the River Landing Post Office, with assistance from River Landing Landscape.

Originally located on October Glory Drive, the Memory Garden was started and maintained by a homeowner and volunteers. When the homeowner sold the adjacent house, the Gardening Committee took over its maintenance. Over the years, the garden had become overgrown and needed a lot of work to revive it. The Gardening Committee investigated moving the garden to a new location because it was not in an area visible to most residents of River Landing. Working with the POA and Landscape Department, it was decided to move it to the Post Office area. The planning started in early 2013 and the garden was completed in early 2014.

Over the years, the garden's plants and trees changed its aesthetic. The large Chinese Elm created too much shade and interfered with the

Post Office roof. The first step was to evaluate what plants should stay and what ones to remove. This evaluation began in February this year and the new plantings were done in June. The Chinese Elm was replaced with a Japanese Maple. Dead or dying plants were removed and replaced with flowering plants that bloom all summer and others that add year-round color. Additionally, annual beds were expanded for more variety and color. We invite you to stop by and enjoy the garden when you visit the Post Office!

Since we began, many talented residents have assisted us with designing and planting. The current Gardening Committee members are: Tony Allen, Diane Brostowin, Jim Brostowin, Julie Couch, Barbara Kukoski, and Lauren Lassman, with help and guidance from Director of Community Operations Stephanie Durner and Landscape Manager Chris Randall.

Choosing the Right Plants

WHEN UNDERTAKING NEW LANDSCAPING PROJECTS OR RENOVATING EXISTING ONES, VARIOUS CHOICES ARE AVAILABLE. EACH YEAR, NEW PLANTS ARE INTRODUCED FROM BOTH PRIVATE NURSERIES AND UNIVERSITIES.

Nurseries like Johnson Nursery offer proven winners, which have been shown to thrive in most local gardens. Universities like NCSU also introduce new plants to the market, working directly with growers throughout the state to bring these plants to both local areas and larger markets.

It's important to remember that not all new plants will be suitable for every garden. Trial and error can help determine what will thrive in a specific area, as microclimates can vary significantly within a single yard. Factors such as shade, full sun, wet and dry conditions, or other environmental variables can influence a plant's success.

Recently, I was asked about planting weeping willows in our area. Weeping willows are short-lived trees but are graceful during their 15-20 year lifespan. They thrive near wetlands or ponds where they can access plenty of water. Native river willows are commonly seen along roadsides and ponds in and out of River Landing. This fall, we will plant a few weeping willows around some of our ponds for accent plantings. When mature, they are beautiful and make great photo backgrounds.

When deciding on a renovation, a total redo, or just a few enhancements, check out these websites for additional ideas and inspiration for transforming your landscape.

River Landing Golf Course Rankings

THE NC GOLF PANEL WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1995 AND IT'S THE PRE-EMINENT, MOST RESPECTED SOURCE OF GOLF COURSE RANKINGS IN NORTH CAROLINA.

Although the panel hasn't been here since May of 2023, when the annual rankings came out in the spring of this year, both courses moved up from the previous year. Officially, the River Course is #20 and the Landing Course is #31 in the state. As you can imagine, the higher the ranking, the harder it is to move up - especially when you have courses like Pinehurst #2 (just hosted the 2024 Men's US Open), Grandfather and CCNC in the top 3. I share this information for every member of the River Landing Sports Club to take pride in. Multiple times each week I hear members come in the Golf Shop and mention to the golf staff that they have traveled to play another course and it is easy to notice on their return how much better the River Landing courses are relative to others.

River Landing Club Decorum

Every member should have received a Membership Plan, including the Rules & Regulations of the Club, when they joined. Even Mr. Bob Miller who joined in 1997 has his Membership

Plan and he might be one of the few who have read it in its entirety (an assumption of mine). Below I will touch on some of the things I've discussed with various members who are unaware of these rules, as well as issues brought to the attention of the Advisory Board of Governors for River Landing. My goal is to help educate, prevent issues from arising, and to help the appropriate staff and management address these issues.

River Landing **Sports** Club is different than the Landing River Community. The Sports Club includes the (2) 18-hole golf courses, practice range and supporting facilities, Clubhouse, and the Fitness Center which includes a heated outdoor pool, health and exercise equipment, pickleball and tennis courts, recreational and other facilities. You must be a paying member of the Sports Club to use its amenities and your membership class will define which facilities you can use and how often.

- No thongs or revealing bathing suits at the pool. The dress code at the pool states: "must wear proper and modest swimming attire".
- Headphones or ear buds are encouraged at the pool however, when not in use volume must be maintained at levels not to disturb others. That means, the volume is for you to hear and not others.
- No glass containers at the pool. It's North Carolina state law.
- All guests at the pool must be accompanied by a Club member or designated user.
- Abuse, verbally or otherwise, reprimand, or discipline of Club personnel will not be tolerated. If a member has a concern, it should be brought to the attention of the manager of the employee.
- While using Club facilities, each member shall possess their membership card. This will help gain access to certain Club facilities as well as make sure your member charges are correct.

- A member may have no more than four guests use the Club's facilities at any one time without the approval of Club Management.
- Adult supervision for children under the age of 16 is required at the Clubhouse, Tennis Courts, Golf Courses (unless approved by the golf professional staff), Fitness Center, and Outdoor Pool.

I am sure there will be more issues I will touch on in the next newsletter article. Please understand, the Membership Plan and Rules & Regulations are not intended to restrict but to guide the membership and staff of River Landing Sports Club to ensure a safe and enjoyable club.



Swing for the Cure

HOPE IS A BEAUTIFUL THING THAT INSPIRES CHANGE AND IS THE DRIVING FACTOR BEHIND THE PURPOSE OF SWING FOR THE CURE.



The River Landing Golf Association for Ladies (RLGALS) initiated Swing for the Cure as an extra Play Day in 2002 resulting in donations of \$575 and donated to the Susan G. Komen Foundation. After becoming an annual event, several years passed before the RLGALS celebrated a donation in excess of \$1,000. Wanting to donate locally, we changed the beneficiary to UNC Lineberger in 2004. The funds were used for Seed Grants, which continues to invest \$100,000 plus for breast cancer needs.

As the event evolved, the Swing added lunch after golf, guests, auctions and raffles and donations started to increase. The famous Helicopter Ball Drop was also added! In 2018, the RLGALS voted to use the event funds in Eastern NC to assist women in need. The perfect recipient became the ECU Cancer Care Center in Greenville serving primarily Eastern NC residents. ECU Health Cancer Care is a premier

cancer care center focusing on increasing clinical trial availability, reducing barriers, increasing awareness of cancer prevention, early screening and detection, and collaborating with the regional ECU Health hospitals.

This year's Swing for the Cure activities include a golf tournament and a luncheon to follow. We are also bringing back Putting for Pink which was started last year—a five hole putting competition open to residents and guests of any age. Hole sponsors take great pride in having their generosity acknowledged when they see their signs prominently displayed. In 2023 more than \$6,000 was donated to ECU.

While all the small events generate money, nothing matches the excitement of the Helicopter Ball Drop. It starts with the purchase of a numbered golf ball which is then loaded into a helicopter with all the other balls. The

Clubhouse Verandah fills up with people in pink. They cheer when the helicopter roars past and wait anxiously as the pilot hovers over a single flagstick in the middle of the fourteenth fairway.
