




To borrow from another famous quote, this one from President John F. Kennedy, "Change is the law of life. And those who look only to the past and present are certain to miss the future."

SUMMERTIME IN NC LANDSCAPES

A few of our favorites include the Ralston Arboretum in Raleigh, the New Hanover County Arboretum in Wilmington, and the North Carolina Arboretum in Asheville—perfect for a quick and refreshing getaway!



Memorial Day is a "Remembrance" and it honors the men and women who died while serving in the US Military. It's a day of mourning, not a day of celebration. At this year's community ceremony, Harry McLaughlin spoke of his family's experience losing his brother Don in Vietnam on January 2nd, 60 years ago. Don was 24 years old. Harry read pieces the last letter his brother wrote to his family, written on Christmas Eve 1965. They received it after his death.

It was tough to keep the tears out of my eyes while Harry read. This story and the many lives lost are why I will always have tears in my eyes and gratitude in my heart for those who

sacrificed their lives for this country. And for my Savior Jesus Christ who died for me, the same tears and gratefulness fill my eyes and heart. Thank you!

July 4th, Independence Day, celebrates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence by the Continental Congress representing the 13 colonies which made up the United States in 1776. Yes, it's a time to display the American Flag with pride, enjoy fireworks, pool parties, pontoon boat rides on the lake or sunning on the beach - and don't forget the hot dogs and hamburgers grilling. It makes me proud and grateful to live in this country, and at the same time my mouth waters for the great American hot dog.

This isn't anything new to most of you reading this article but my hope in writing this is three fold. First, we need to teach our children this country wouldn't be great without those who died serving the United States of America. Second, don't let commercialization overtake the meaning of Memorial Day. Finally, don't say "Happy Memorial Day". It's not a happy day, but a solemn day of remembering. This is why I asked everyone attending our Memorial Day Service at the Clubhouse circle to leave in silence after the playing of taps, remembering those who died and sacrificed their lives in protecting this country.

RIVER LANDING CLUB DECORUM

Every member should have received a Membership Plan including the Rules & Regulations. I am going to touch on some of the things I've discussed with various members who are unaware of these rules, as well as issues brought to the attention of the Advisory Board of Governors for River Landing. My goal is to educate, to help prevent issues from arising, and to help the appropriate staff and management deal with these matters.

- A member may have no more than four guests us the Club's facilities at any one time without the approval of Club Management.
- Adult supervision for children under the age of 16 is required at the Clubhouse, Tennis Courts, Golf Course (unless approved by the golf professional staff), Fitness Center, Outdoor Pool.
- Hopefully the Golf Cart GPSs are fine-tuned as they are intended which is to enhance your golf experience while controlling golf cart traffic and wear patterns. If you have any problems, please note the golf cart number and communicate to the golf professional staff.
- In the best interest of the entire membership, we ask all members to cancel their tee times 72 hours in advance. This provides more tee time options for our members who choose to book closer to their desired date. If you have trouble, please contact the golf shop to adjust.
- River Landing Sports Club is different than the River Landing community. The Sports Club includes the (2) 18-hole golf courses, practice range and supporting facilities, Clubhouse, Fitness Center which includes a heated outdoor pool, health and exercise equipment, pickleball and tennis courts and other recreational facilities. You must be a paying member of the Sports Club to use its amenities and your Membership Class will define which facilities you can use and how often.
- Headphones or ear buds are encouraged at the pool. If you are not using them, the volume on personal devices must be maintained at levels so as not to disturb others. That means, the volume is for you to hear and not others.
- No glass containers at the pool, it's NC State Law.
- Abuse, verbally or otherwise, reprimand or discipline of Club personnel will not be tolerated. If a member has a concern, it should be brought to the attention of the manager of the employee.
- Membership Cards: Please carry your membership card when using Club facilities. It helps with access and ensures your charges are processed correctly.

I am sure there will be more issues I will touch on in the future. Please understand, the Membership Plan and Rules & Regulations are not intended to restrict, but to guide the membership and staff of River Landing Sports Club in a safe and enjoyable club.

That said, we do want to address an area of growing concern: cart traffic. Recently, we've noticed more frequent instances of groups of three or four players using three or more carts. This not only adds unnecessary wear and tear on the course but also limits cart availability, particularly during busy times.

To help preserve course conditions and ensure everyone has access to carts:
Groups of 3 or 4 players should limit themselves to no more than 2 carts.
If a player prefers to ride solo, a single cart fee will be applied. The player who did not request to ride solo will not be charged.

We kindly ask for your cooperation in minimizing cart usage whenever possible. This small adjustment can make a big difference in maintaining the beauty and playability of our courses.


Landing did a great job with the Tapas-style food, and DJ Jody and Sabrina kept us all on the dance floor.


